

Here is a little offering. Inspired by both Mr K's Puppy Linux and Antonio Sanguigni alias slapshot 's Edupup.



I wanted to make this as comprehensive as possible and aim it at Linux Noobs running Daddies Vista machine to run as a Livecd (2and half mins initial load on lappy 1.6ghz cpu and 1gb ram)and also be able to run on a P3 with 128mb ram as a full install

Using Barebones 4.1.2 as its base. its 209mb and its core app is Gcompris 8.4.2.

Bugger all screen shots, but the background is the same as Edupup. Kids Stuff

Note: I have made this local to the UK. I have stripped out the other languages from Gcompris (which I will post in a separate folder). Gcompris is set to En-GB. Just run CLI `gcompris -a` and go to boards to change once the relevant voice folder is inserted. If you get an error along the lines of "Gcompris lock....." Go to `/root/.config/gcompris/` and edit the line locale in the `gcompris.conf` file.

It was getting an ever expanding waistline. So I installed the following libs so with a click of a mouse Pingus, Supertux, Ri-li, Little Wizard and Lletters (Flash cards for letters and numbers) can be installed. Note that I am going to update the lletters game with pics and new sounds. There is also scope for more. As it's aimed at the uninitiated people may still think a dependency is a small country from the days of empire, ease em in.

Browser

Firepup is the default browser and has some bookmarks in already, mainly to kids siteseg Nasa kids and Cbeebies etc.. If you want a parental control Pro con latte V1.6

A Puppy bookmarks folder and a link to Linuxprinting.org printer database.

I have also put an RSS ticker on. I have a RSS calendar where I will transmit calendar events such as national nuts and berries week (you go out with the kids and collect acorns etc and spread them around or grow them). Plus national days. Get rid of the live bookmark to rid yourself of this.

A version of this is being trialed at a nursery and there are a 3 others out there also playing with it.

As a result:

There is a big shiny icon on the desktop "Shut down"

The desktop icons are double click

The drive icons have been turned off, have to use Pmount

The root folder has been moved and the my-documents folder is on the desktop.

Inside the docs folder is a shortcut to a downloads folder, firepup will download anything to that.

There is a doc called Welcome with notes on the apps and some instructions on connecting to the web and little something on printing. There is also a little instruction pamphlet on booting and the saving personal settings (2fs), which I will upload when I have it finished as thats the boring bit, so its been put off till last.

If you fancy taking all the menus away so its a kiosk look (less temptation) edit the file in /etc/xdg/templates/_root_jwmrc. Be sure to put add shortcuts to all the apps you want on the desktop as some are accessed via the Fun menu.

If i manage to get Childsplay up and running i will do one based on that. I will rebuild this without the localisation, or i could just do a barebones with Gcompris and you can take it from there. Let me know.
